The items consist of a silver starters whistle, made by Vaughton of Birmingham and hallmarked Birmingham 1906, with his initials 'G.W.H.' to barrel. In original red leather box with his initials to box in gold. Plus four large original silver plated officials badges, two entitled 'Judge' and the others 'Time-keeper' and 'Referee', with ornate Olympic emblem to centre and blue enamel ring with Olympic Games title and officials position, floral decoration to outer edge. Sold with Hearne's official medal for the Olympic Games held in London. Silver metal medal, 2" diameter, designed by B. Mackennal and produced by Vaughtons of Birmingham (tarnished) and a small framed image of Hearne dressed in riding attire. The medal is tarnished but all other items in good condition. An interesting collection from the first London Olympic Games. £400/600
- George William Hearne was the main founder and first President of FINA (Federation Internationale De Natation, International Swimming Federation) and was President from 1908-1924*

- 725 New Zealand tour of Great Britain 1907/08. 'Souvenir of the New Zealand Rugby Football Team 1907/08'. - This was New Zealand's first tour of Great Britain. New Zealand won the three Test series in England 2-1 and lost to Wales in the only Test*
- 726 William Henry Barlow. Broughton Rangers Rugby League Club 1910/11. 'Northern Union (later Rugby League Challenge) Cup winners gold medal awarded to William Barlow, who played at stand-off for Broughton Rangers. The very attractive 15ct gold and enamel medal, by Fattorini & Sons of Bradford, with inscription 'Lancashire, Cheshire, Yorkshire. Northern Rugby Football Union Challenge Cup' and decorated with coats of arms of the northern counties etc plus golden rugby ball to top. To verso the inscription 'Northern Union Challenge Cup won by Broughton Rangers 1910-11. W.H. Barlow'. Hallmarked. Some small loss to enamel otherwise in good/very good condition £1000/1500
- Broughton Rangers won the Challenge Cup for the second time (won previously in 1902) by beating Wigan 4-0 in the Final held at the Weaste, Salford. A crowd of 8,000 attended the Final, the pitch was waterlogged after two days of torrential rain. The game was decided by two penalty goals from Billy Harris, Broughton's best player on the day*
- 727 International programmes 1957-2001. Collection of forty programmes for the period, the majority England home programmes. Original silk commemorative programme for the match played on the 6th August 1904 at Christchurch. The silk programme has a photographic image of the British team printed in blue to top half with title and players names below, to lower half are the players names and clubs printed in red with team titles in team formation. Blue borders to edges of silk. Printed by Willis & Aiken of Christchurch. Very good condition. A rare early item £250/350
- Great Britain beat Canterbury, South Canterbury and Westland 5-3 in the match*
