- 1056 Commonwealth Games, Edinburgh. Scotland, 1986. A steel ceremonial sword, by Wilkinson of London, used for the Opening Ceremony XIII Commonwealth Games, Scotland, 1986, with pierced basket and engraved knuckle guards, shagreen grips with twist decoration, the full Royal warrant and full ceremonial engraving to one side of the blade reading 'Opening Ceremony XIII Commonwealth Games, Scotland, 1986'. 34" long. The 1986 Edinburgh Commonwealth Games were in a financial crisis in the run up to the games, when Robert Maxwell MP came to the rescue and offered to help out amid much publicity, mostly from his own newspapers. His one major contribution was to order the most expensive swords manufactured by Wilkinson and have them all individually engraved for a sword dance by a huge troupe of Scottish dancers, which was part of the opening ceremony and lasted about three minutes. The bill was in excess of £200,000. Shortly after Robert Maxwell pulled out of his rescue bid claiming disagreements. The Edinburgh rate payers picked up the bill.
A similar sword was presented to the Queen at the opening ceremony
